It was commonly eaten with honey and sugar; tomato sauce was not added until the 17th and 18th centuries. There are currently more than 500 different types of pasta in Italy today.

Indian cuisine evolved based on the cultural interactions of the Mongols, Persians, Arabs, Portuguese traders in the 16th century including the French and English during the colonial era adding diversity to the Indian cuisine! March 25, 1647, the Dutch East India Company (VOC) ship Nieuw Haarlem or Haarlem was wrecked in Table Bay, off the coast of South Africa. The sailors who lived there for a year found the locals to be very friendly and the soil extremely fertile. Upon returning home, they submitted their findings and the Dutch East India Company was established. Jan van Riebeeck was in charge of managing the station and planting vineyards for the production of wine and grapes in the Wijnberg (wine mountain area), so as to ward off scurvy for sailors during their voyages along the spice route.
